THURSDAY 22ND 9.30 until 10.30 am at Headquarters. Competitors must produce their current NSWFCA
Registration card or proof of current NSWFCA membership if issue of registration card is pending.

INDIVIDUAL ELIGIBILITY: Financial Registered members of affiliated clubs of NSWFCA.
Competitors may enter one category only for which they qualify by age or gender.

TEAM ELIGIBILITY: Competitors 55 years & over and under 18 years have the choice of
competing in their age or their gender category i.e. S-Vet/Vet.male/Junior Boy may compete as a
member of the Mens team (18-54) whilst competing in the individual category as a Veteran Male or
Junior Boy. Veteran Lady/Junior Girl may compete as a member of Ladies team.

BOUNDARIES – WESTERN: To the West upstream as far as salt water species are in habitat but
not above the Pacific Highway bridge at Kempsey.

MACLEAY RIVER - ANGLERS ON FOOT - EASTERN SEAWARD BOUNDARY-
Marked signpost approximately 10 metres back from the tips of each of the Southern and Northern
Breakwalls and being an imaginary line across the river. The Eastern tip/end of each wall is OUT OF
BOUNDS. All fishing confirmed to within the river system.

MACLEAY RIVER – ANGLERS IN BOATS - EASTERN SEAWARD BOUNDARY.
Direct line, at right angles across the river from "No Hire Boats Pass this Sign" located on the Southern side
of the Macleay River to the northern side breakwall. **BOAT ANGLERS WHO PROCEED EAST OF THIS LINE
WILL BE DISQUALIFIED** this being a declared OUT OF BOUNDS FOR BOATS by the NSWFCA.

BACK CREEK, SOUTH WEST ROCKS.

An imaginary line between the Markers on both sides of the seaward end of the creek.

10 SPECIES AWARDS: Heaviest Bream, Flathead, Luderick, Mulloway, Tailor, Whiting,
Heaviest other eligible specie and Most number of different eligible species (if equal number - heaviest bag).
RESTRICTED TO JUNIORS & SUB-JUNIORS : Heaviest Mullet; Heaviest Garfish.

RULES: FISH TO BE WEIGHED WHOLE – NO ALLOWANCE WILL BE MADE FOR FISH PRESENTED
GILLED AND GUTTED. Competition conducted in accordance with the NSWFCA By- Laws and NSW Fisheries
Saltwater Regulations. Competitors are not permitted to weigh fish caught outside the stated fishing times.
