OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

The management of NSWFCA Inc. is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy environment for its members and anyone entering upon utilized premises or with connection to the Association's operations.

In demonstrating Management's duty of care, the Association will make every reasonable effort to provide an environment that minimises incidents of risk or personal injury, ill health or damage to property. This includes:

- Providing members with appropriate training.
- Providing safe equipment and systems of work
- Regular consultation on health and safety issues

A safe working culture is the responsibility of everyone and this can be best achieved through cooperative efforts of members. A safe culture will be reinforced through:

- Continually identifying, assessing and controlling possible risks to the health and safety of people that may arise in the workplace.
- The provision of information concerning such risks and the promotion, instruction, training and supervision of employees to ensure safe work practices.
- Giving members the opportunity to participate in health and safety decisions that affect them.

In the interests of maintaining safety, contractors, employees, visitors and members are required to observe and comply with all health and safety standards and rules produced. This includes any safety signage or warnings, or instruction given by any member whilst on utilized premises.
